

# STATELINE CAMPRESORT AND CABINS

Take a break on the peaceful side of New England



**T** rue to its name, Stateline Campresort sits right on the border of Connecticut and Rhode Island. It's a tranquil, verdant part of New England where you can unwind at your leisure in wooded serenity. On the other hand, if you're eager for activity, you'll find plenty to do at this Coast Classic Resort.

Start your tour at Stateline's main lodge, home to an adult lounge and an all-ages entertainment center packed with coin-operated video games, skee-ball and pool tables. You'll also find the camp store here, as well as convenient laundry facilities and clean restrooms.

Just outside is an open pavilion, a patio complex and a large L-shaped swimming pool with a slide. You can play horseshoes, softball, volleyball and basketball, cool off at the new spray ground or rent a rowboat and set off on a restful float or a fishing foray on the private lake.

There's never a dull moment at this family-oriented campground, unless you'd prefer to do nothing but relax at your RV campsite. Take advantage of the free Wi-Fi to check the resort's website and see what's happening during your visit. Planned activities range from potlucks and barbecues to DJs, live entertainment, sporting events, fishing contests, crafts, hayrides and theme weeks.

Offsite, you can try your luck at two nearby casinos, take a drive through the beautiful countryside or visit Mystic Seaport and Old Sturbridge Village.
